Health World, a local charity, has teamed up with MacDonald's Ranch and our sponsor the Scottsdale Charros to help bring a unique program to children who have never been involved with horses before and do not have the financial ability to participate in the equestrian sport.

Horsense is more than a horse riding program. It is an alternative after school program which engages children in learning about respect, responsibility and development of character. The five week long program will be held every Saturday at MacDonald's Ranch in Scottsdale, Arizona. The 2 1/2 hour session is broken into 2 sections. The Equine program is under the direction and guidance of Louise Hoffaker, an experienced trainer with 35 years of experience. Students will learn about basic riding, safety and care of the horse. The Life Skills program will be taught by Health World educators. Students will learn skills about making better choice with classes on drugs, alcohol and tobacco. Additionally, students will learn about first aid, desert survival and team building. Arizona Game and Fish, The Phoenix Herpetological Society and The Scottsdale Mounted Police will visit the camp and assist in programming.
