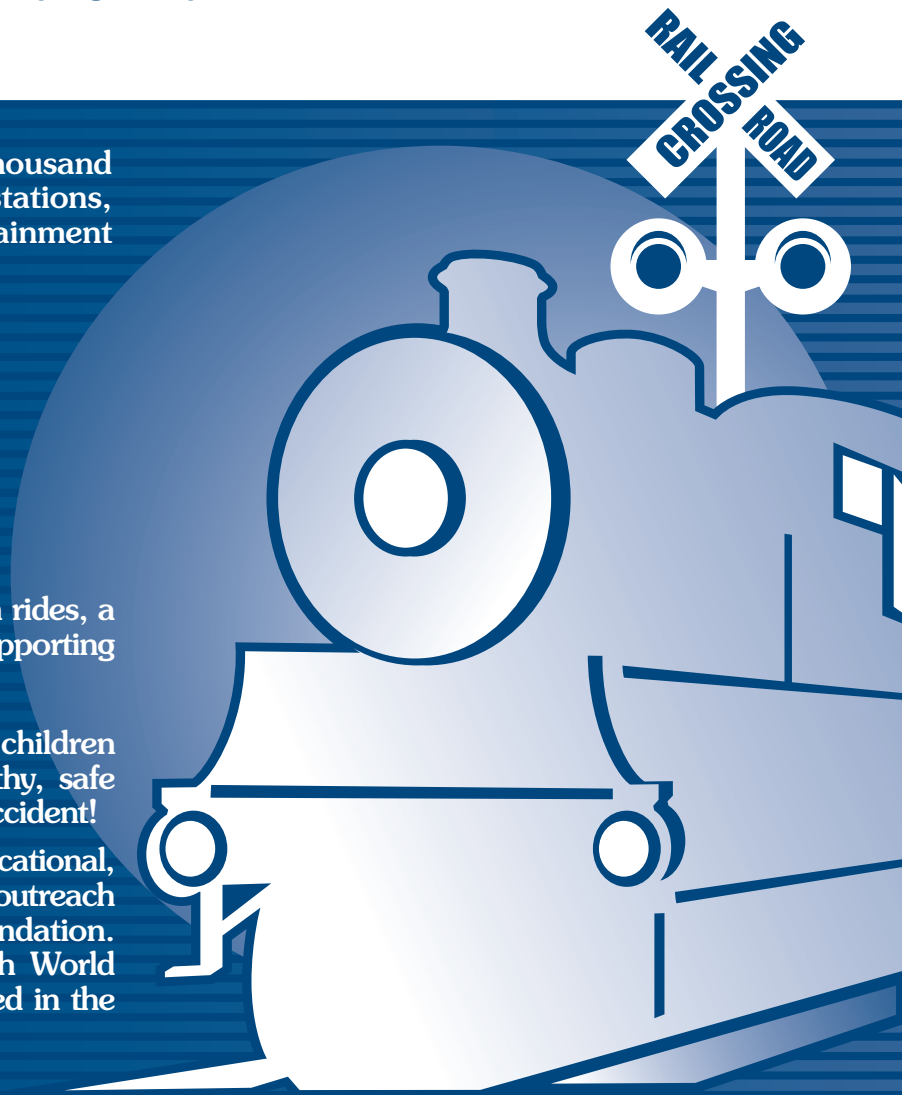


During the two week program, over three thousand 2nd graders will participate in learning stations, each tailored to provide interaction, entertainment and education. The many stops included:

- Eating Right, Staying Fit
- A few "side trips" including carousel and train rides, a visit to the Train Park Museum; and crafts supporting the health and safety messages.
